GENERAL RULES OF PLAY

- All students are to be treated fairly, respectfully, responsibly and inclusively at all times
- There can be no physical contact between any students at any time
- Students shall not be excluded from any informal team or group game. In Years 3 6, where a competitive
 game occurs between two even numbered teams, a student may be excluded if they request inclusion more
 than fifteen minutes after the start of a recess time. In this event, it is the responsibility of this student to
 find another student to also participate, to ensure there are fair and even numbers
- Prep 2 students only shall have use of the Adventure Playground at the main Lunch Recess break and Years
 3 6 only shall have use of the synthetic turf pitch at this time. Prep 2 and Years
 3 6 then swap play areas for the afternoon recess break. Any year level has use of the grassed oval area at all times
- All sports equipment shall be treated with respect and care. If used, it must be returned to the owner, the sports box, sports shed or rope hooks by the end of each recess break
- The following areas are out of bounds at all times : the bike racks, behind the Prep classrooms, inside the Physical Education/Sports and Visual Arts storerooms, the Car Park behind the Church and the outer side of all school fences
- Before 9.00 am, during recess times and after 3.40 pm, school buildings are out of bounds to all students
- ♦ For student safety, if it has been or is raining, or if it is before 9.00 am and after 3.30 pm, all grassed areas and the Adventure Playground is out of bounds
- Play equipment of any kind shall not be used after 3.30 pm
- For student safety, climbing on or over any fences, trees, seating or on top of any adventure playground equipment is not permitted
- Outdoor play equipment shall not be used inside school buildings.
- When 'Wet Day' or 'Hot Day' programmes confine students to their classrooms, students shall only play
 passive games that are available in their learning areas
- Foods of any kind may only be consumed in the classrooms, on verandahs and on the asphalted play areas
- School staff are the only persons to retrieve balls and other play equipment from out of bounds areas
- For student safety, student line up shall be in 'roll order' in class group designated areas, two minutes after the first bell at 8.45 am, 11.50 am and 2.25 pm. Playground clean up, toilet and drink stops need to occur immediately after the first bell
- Students are responsible for ensuring all litter is placed in rubbish bins. As a consequence, all students will clean
 and maintain their designated outdoor area at the end of each recess break (11.50 am and 2.25 pm), as
 specified below
- <u>Daily Student Designated Cleaning Areas</u>:
- Prep students are responsible for the cleaning of the Adventure Playground Area, including around and in all sandpits, Volley ball court area, garden areas outside their classrooms and the area behind their classrooms;
- > Year 1/2s are responsible for the cleaning of their verandah areas, basketball court and area outside the school back entrance sliding doors;
- > Year 3/4s are responsible for the cleaning of their verandah areas, Tuckshop area, re-cycling bins area between their classrooms and the sports storeroom and the sheltered area (including under the stage);
- > Year 5/6s are responsible for cleaning and maintaining the synthetic turf, grassed, oval area and all adjacent garden beds, including around the water tanks;
- > Clean up is expected to take no more than the first 2 minutes after each recess bell
